



CERTIFICATE OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CFR)

One of the regulatory requirements for issuing the document for a student visa is that credible documentation of sufficient finances be on file with the school. You have two options to demonstrate available funds from a savings and/or checking accounts. Proof of funds cannot be more than six months old when the I-20 is processed.

1. * A bank official may complete and sign the bank section at the bottom of the CFR to certify that funds are available in the specified account (preferred).
2. If the bank cannot sign the CFR, attach an official bank letter/statement with an official signature and stamp.
